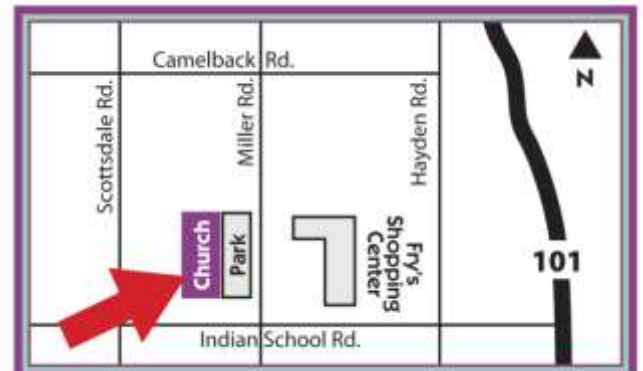
Jim Garrison is leading our critique for February

# DESERT BOTANICAL GARDEN SHOW

## 2011 RULES

Please review the rules and if you have any questions, direct them to a DBG Show Committee Member.

1. Paintout dates are March 5, 12, 19, 26 (Every Saturday in March) from 9:00 AM to 4:00 PM. Artists can enter at 9:00 AM, and must sign in at the information table. We encourage everyone to attend all four Saturday paintouts, as it is to your best advantage to be there painting and meeting clients.
2. Final sale dates are April 1, 2, 3: Friday, April 1 from 9:00 AM to 6:00 PM with an artists meet and greet from 4-6 PM, Saturday April 2 from 9:00 AM to 5:00 PM, and Sunday April 3 from 9:00 AM to 4:00 PM.
3. The participation fee is \$40, which you will receive:
  - Free admittance to the DBG for the 4 paint days and the 3 sale days. You can paint on the sale days, too, if you're not scheduled to work.
  - A commemorative t-shirt and nametag (both to be worn during the event.)
  - Exposure to thousands of potential buyers. Your contact info will be included on the promotional flyer.
  - A chance to sell, get to know your fellow S.A.L. members, and have fun!
3. Each participant is expected to volunteer four (4) hours of time to the event. There are many jobs that need to be done before the actual event, throughout the Month of March and on the sale days. The information table will need the most hours, so please see the Scheduling Committee regarding the information table shifts.
4. You should have a professional-looking painting set-up, like an easel or a small folding chair and table.
5. You can paint anywhere except inside the butterfly pavilion, as long as you keep on the trails. Don't block traffic, signage, or special displays. Please move quickly and courteously if a DBG employee asks you to move.
6. It is wise to set up within eyesight of another artist so you can watch each other's things for bathroom/lunch breaks. (Always keep your valuables with you.) Greet patrons in a friendly helpful way, to encourage questions and interaction.
7. Paint the scenery there, no painting from photo references, even your own. There will be a meeting and demonstration giving some tips about this particular location, and painting outside in general, before the March paintout begins.
8. At your painting location you cannot have finished paintings to show to patrons besides the ones you are currently working on. No prints, cards or anything else for sale at the painting locations. If you have these things for sale, check them in at the information table. You can also leave one extra original at the information table staff to sell. If you sell one of the originals you have with you, either accompany the client to the Information/sale table to buy it, or if you feel you can't leave, call the sales table for a runner to come. (Although this latter option may take a few minutes.)
9. Each artist will be given a few S.A.L. Newsletters with membership application forms. If you meet a garden patron who is an artist, encourage them to join S.A.L.
10. At the final weekend, each artist will be assigned one side of a panel for their original paintings. Framing and wiring standards for all our S.A.L. shows apply. If you also have cards and prints, let the Sales/Reception Committee know in advance so they can divide up the tables equally. We will provide tables, you don't have to bring one. Set-up day on April 1, all work has to be delivered at 8:30 AM. After 9:30 AM any remaining open panels will be hung with artists additional paintings. If you cannot make it by the times specified, prior arrangements must be made with the Sales/Reception Committee and/or a fellow artist, or your panel may be forfeited.
11. Sales at the Garden: 20% to DBG, 10% to S.A.L., and 70% to the artist.
12. For new members, the "Standing Rule" will be waived for this event. This will be fun! We look forward to painting with all of you for our "Sweet 16 Years at the Garden!"
