Presentation for AUGUST 3rd

Carole Hillsbery has been painting in transparent watercolors and has studied with such notable artists as Robert E. Wood, Charles Reid, Diane Maxey and Ted Nuttall. Carole describes herself a "shape maker" starting with large fresh washes of color and working toward smaller, more intense shapes and colors that define the subject. She is an impressionist in her approach to her work which has been described as "meticulously imprecise" as she thoughtfully and carefully builds shapes to represent her subject.

A signature member of the Transparent Watercolor Society of America, Western Federation of Watercolor Societies and the Arizona Watercolor Association, she has won numerous awards and was featured artist in the Dec 06 American Artist magazine, Mar 10 issue of Southwest Art. *"It is my desire in the workshops I teach and demos I do to inspire artists to loosen up, put aside that "need" to make a perfect painting and just have fun discovering all the amazing things water media can do! Those members arriving with work after 6:30 risk not having their work critiqued depending on volume of work brought in earlier. One painting per person, please.

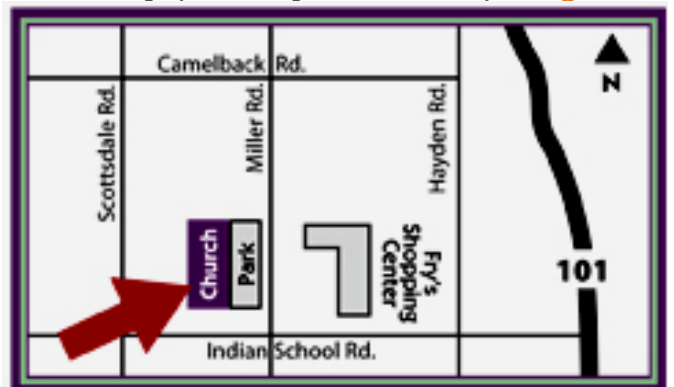

2. A two dimensional art must be framed or on gallery wrapped canvas must be 1 ½ "minimum.
3. If you have had your art critiqued at that meeting, you may not also enter it in "Artwork of the Month."
4. If you are a first, second, or third place winner, please remain after the meeting to be photographed for the Art Beat.
5. Each artist may win first place only once a year (January to November).
6. All monthly first place winners will bring a piece of artwork to the December meeting to vie for "Artist of the Year." Monthly winners may enter any piece of work they wish in the December "Artist of the Year" contest. This allows sales and gives artists the freedom to exhibit what they feel is their best effort.

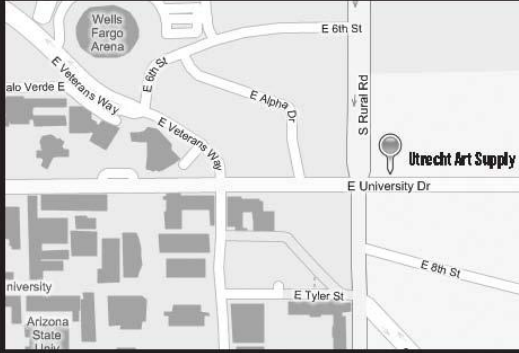
